Developing sites on brownfield land in London for urban regeneration is the speciality of this company. Mount Anvil builds houses and apartments on sites mainly within the M25, around half of which are affordable-home projects for housing associations. Its developments have ranged from a gated estate at Kings Cross to student housing and sports facilities at Kingston University in Surrey. The company has its headquarters in St Albans, and over the past three years has donated £250,000 to charitable causes. Chief executive Killian Hurley founded Mount Anvil in 1991, and its profits have grown 117% a year from £660,000 in 2004 to £6.7m in 2007.
